Young people from 119 countries entered the competition from as far afield as Romania, New Zealand, Trinidad and Tobago, and 94 percent of postcodes in the UK!

The awards ceremony took place at The Globe Theatre in London. With 15 winners and 85 commended poets, Jack (Y11) was commended for his poem 'Moth'.

A fantastic achievement Jack, well done!



The Cotswold School 1st XI football team






